Kids going into 2nd grade up to kids going into 6th grade will begin Thursday, June 9th and run through Thursday, July 28th (8 weeks).

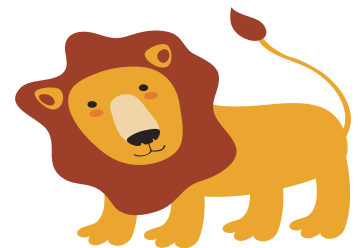
Registration begins Monday, May 9th to Monday, June 6th.
