WHEN: Saturday, June 25, 2011 from 9AM -1PM

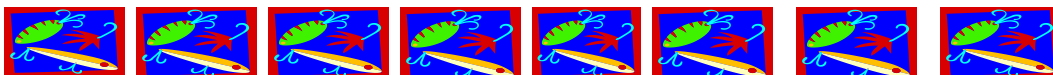
FOR: Children, age 3 yrs. Through 3rd grade with their special Male Role Model (Dad, Grandpa, Uncle, etc.)
