# Play Group & Story Hour

The single most significant factor influencing a child's early education success is an introduction to books and being read to at home prior to beginning school (National Commission on Reading, 1985). The Suring Area Public Library wants to help you and your children find your way to educational success. Join us on Tuesdays at 10:00am for Story Hour.

Story Hour is geared toward children ages two to pre-kindergarten but all children are welcome to participate. Each week we read a few books and do a craft. We might sing some songs and play a learning game or two also. You never know what fun Jill will have planned.

Story Hour is a wonderful time and

we ask that all caregivers participate with their children. Modeling the behavior teaches the children how they should act. It is amazing to watch their little minds figure everything out.

dren at 9:00am on Tuesdays you can be a part of Play Group. This group is hosted by the UW-Extension Parent Resource Center and geared to children ages birth to pre-kindergarten.

Playgroup meets each week for an hour. This time is used for children to interact with others in their age group. They learn skills such as sharing and working together. The caregivers get a chance to talk with other caregivers and exchange information that is beneficial as you raise your book loving children.
